2. To work under the direction of and reports to the Attorney General on all matters of a legal nature.
3. Responds to the Attorney General on all other matters and the Permanent Secretary whenever necessary.

**DUTIES AND TASKS**

1. Functions as the Delegate of the Attorney General.
2. Manages the day-to-day operations of the Advice and Litigation Unit to ensure the provision of effective legal services to the Government of Saint Lucia.
3. Supervises the work of staff of the Legal Services Division within Chambers to ensure that legal services are provided in an efficient and effective manner.
4. Supervises the preparation and implementation of work programmes of legal officers.
5. Appears and represents the Government in Civil matters in the High Court and Court of Appeal.
6. Arranges for Government representation in Civil matters in the High Court and Court of Appeal.
7. Tenders legal opinion and advises Government Ministries and Departments in Civil Matters.

8. Vets legal documents and agreements.
9. Prepares progress reports and makes recommendations on matters relating to Chambers, to the Attorney General and Permanent Secretary whenever necessary.
10. Represents the office of the Attorney General on various Statutory and other Boards and Committees.
11. Represents the Attorney General at official activities.

### REQUEST FOR 'EXPRESSION OF INTEREST' – APPOINTMENT AS JUDICIAL MANAGER OF AN INSURANCE COMPANY

The Financial Services Regulatory Authority ('the Authority') has responsibility for the administration of the Insurance Act, Cap 12.08 of the Revised Laws of Saint Lucia ('the Insurance Act'), including the supervision of Insurance Companies registered under the Insurance Act.

In accordance with Section 40 of the Insurance Act, the Authority, after exercising the Power of Intervention conferred to it under Section 37 (1) of this Act, may apply to the Court for an order to place an insurance company under Judicial Management.

The Authority invites suitably qualified firms/individuals to indicate their interest in providing Judicial Management services.

#### Scope of Services Required:

In accordance with Section 42 of the Insurance Act, the judicial manager shall conduct the management of the insurance company with the greatest economy compatible with efficiency, and shall as soon as possible after his or her appointment, file with the court a report stating which of the following courses is in the circumstances, in his or her opinion most advantageous to the general interests of the policy holders of the company —

- (a) the transfer of the business of the company to some other company in pursuance of a scheme to be prepared in accordance with this Act (whether the policies of the business continue for the original

sums insured, with the addition of bonuses that are attached to the policies, or for reduced amounts);

- (b) the carrying on of its business by the company (whether the policies of the business continue for the original sums insured, with the addition of bonuses that attach to the policies, or for reduced amounts);
- (c) the winding up of the company or of any part of the business of the company; or
- (d) the dealing with part of the business of the company in one manner, and with another part in another manner.

THE Government of Saint Lucia through the Ministry of Commerce, International Trade, Investment, Enterprise Development and Consumer Affairs is inviting tenders for the supply of Wheat Flour for the period June 2021 to May 2022. The required specifications are shown hereunder:

<b>1. Characteristics</b>	<b>Requirements</b>
Moisture content	- not more than 15%
Ash content:	- not more than 1.2% before adding inorganic matter
Protein content:	- 12.0 – 13.5%

**2. Packaging Requirements**

Wheat Flour shall be packaged in containers that will safeguard the hygienic, nutritional, and technological characters of the flour, and protect it against contamination or absorption of moisture.

Containers shall be made of materials that are safe and suitable for the purpose, such as bags or sacks made of new cotton cloth, multi-wall paper, strong paper and new plastic film.

Containers shall not contaminate the product by migration of any toxic substance, or give the flour any undesirable odor or flavour.

**3. Labelling Requirements**

The labeling on retail packages of flour shall be in the English Language, clearly and prominently displayed, and readily legible under customary conditions of purchase and use.

**3-a** The information carried on the label shall include the following:

- (a) The name of the food, "Flour", "Wheat Flour" or "White Flour"
- (b) Any brand name or trade name
- (c) The name of the manufacturer or of the person controlling the brand name or trade name, together with an adequate postal address
- (d) The name of the country of origin
- (e) The net contents of each package when packed in terms of units of mass in grams (g) or kilograms (Kg)0 , (which may also be shown in avoirdupois pounds and ounces) using Arabic numerals
- (f) The batch number, date of manufacture, together with expiry date or best before date of minimum durability
- (g) Handling and Storage instructions

Where the vitamins and minerals are present in the flour, the amount of each present in 100 g of flour (at 15% moisture content) shall be declared, expressed in milligrams (mg), and the flour may be described as "enriched", or "vitamin enriched";

**3-b** Where an indication of the type of flour is included on the label, the protein and ash contents of the flour shall be within the limits set out in **Table 1 b** of the compulsory standard for Wheat Flour (*SLNS 24: 2015*).

Bread	12.0 to 13.5 %	up to 0.5 %
Cake, Pastry	7.0 to 10.0 %	up to 0.45 %
Other	13.5 to 15.5%	up to 0.7%

#### 4. Transportation

Wheat Flour shall be shipped containerized in vessels suitable for transporting foodstuffs for human consumption.

#### 5. Quality Assurance

It is required that Wheat Flour be produced in accordance with the compulsory standard for Wheat Flour (SLNS 24: 2015).

Each shipment should be accompanied by a **Certificate of Compliance**.

A **Certificate of Product test** results in conformity with the specifications stipulated in the tender notice must be submitted annually.

A **Microbiological test report** issued by a third party laboratory or a test laboratory within certified facilities must accompany each shipment.

#### 6. Quantity

One hundred and forty-five thousand (145,000) bags of flour (100 lbs) or a part thereof in monthly shipments to be agreed between the Supplier and Buyer for a period of twelve (12) consecutive months at most, commencing June 2021 to May 2022.

#### 7. Weight

Flour must be packed in strong bags of not more than 100 pounds.

#### 8. Insurance

Insurance coverage must provide for settlement of entire amount of lawful claims.

#### 9. Payment Terms

60 – 90 days at sight.

#### 10. Country of Origin

Information on the country of origin, must be provided.

All quotations (C.I.F) and credit facilities must be forwarded to the Secretary, Central Tenders Board, Ministry of Finance to reach no later than **4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 30, 2021**.


The opening Hours for the building will be as follows:
